

Guidelines for the
MacKenzie Payne Memorial Scholarship Fund

The **MacKenzie Payne Memorial Scholarship Fund** of Newman Regional Health Foundation was created in memory of MacKenzie Payne to provide medical career-minded seniors of Emporia High School in Emporia (Lyon County), Kansas the opportunity to pursue their vocation at an accredited 2-year or 4-year institution of higher education. Scholarships will be awarded on the basis of scholarship and leadership.

In order to apply for this scholarship, eligible candidates must:

1. Be a senior currently attending Emporia High School in Emporia, KS;
2. Have a grade point average of 3.0 or better (on a 4.0 scale);
3. Complete graduation requirements at Emporia High School by the date of commencement;
4. Be enrolled or accepted for enrollment in an approved college, university, vocational, or technical training school in healthcare, dental, or health-related plan of study (major);
5. And complete the Miscellaneous application form and a one-page essay (12-point font size, double spaced) explaining why the applicant wants to pursue a career in healthcare or a related health career.

Scholarship checks will be made payable to the University.
