Scholarship Criteria

- 1. Major consideration will be given to a student that influences others by example, preservers despite difficulties, lives simply and whose faith is strong.
- 2. Each application must have these requirements:
 - Completed application form
 - Written essay, which demonstrates the four principles of courage, integrity, responsibility and concern
 - Transcript of high school grades
 - Two letters of recommendation detailing the student's work ethic and integrity, (non-family member)
 - Financial need will be a consideration
 - 2.5 minimum GPA
- 3. Recipients will receive their scholarships:
 - After successfully completing first semester

Students must present a receipt of payment after enrolling at their respected college/university/technical school. This applies to payments made for the 2nd semester requests for payments to the SLCEF.

Checks will be made to the designated college.

Scholarships will expire in two (2) years from date of application and funds will be moved to an unrestricted SLCEF scholarship account.
